Death of Mr Bouamama

It is with deep regret that I inform you of the Death of Mr Redouane Bouamama.

Mr Bouamama was taken ill in the afternoon of 2nd December on the Harmondsworth. Staff and on site medical staff attended to Mr Bouamama and carried out CPR until an emergency ambulance arrived. Despite valiant efforts from everyone involved all attempts to save his life failed and Mr Bouamama was pronounced dead at 1529.

Mr Bouamama is from Algeria and attempts are now being made to contact his next of Kin.

Events such as these can affect us all in different ways. Please take the time over the next few days to ensure anyone affected by these tragic events are directed to the available support services. If you or a fellow detainee require any support regarding this issue, please do not hesitate to contact any member of my staff or a member of the Healthcare team. Our Religious Affairs Team will also be available for pastoral support during this time.

If you are concerned about a fellow detainee or indeed just want to speak to someone about any of your own concerns, please raise this with a member of staff immediately.

As with all deaths in custody this matter will now be investigated by Care & Custody, the Prison and Probation Ombudsman and the NHS.
